

FREE MONEY FOR COLLEGE!

Sound too good to be true? It's not.

If you live in Amelia, Dinwiddie or Sussex counties, you may qualify for a scholarship that covers tuition and fees at John Tyler Community College. It's all thanks to the Tobacco Region Revitalization Commission, which generously supports the Tobacco Region Scholarship Program at John Tyler.

Here's how it works.

Tobacco Region Scholarships are awarded three times a year. Students who meet the necessary qualifications may be awarded a scholarship that pays for tuition and fees not covered by financial aid.

To qualify, you must:

- Reside in Amelia, Dinwiddie or Sussex counties
- Apply for admission to John Tyler Community College (you may apply online at www.jtcc.edu)
- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Enroll in a certificate or degree program at John Tyler that is tied to science, technology, engineering, mathematics, or health care - known as STEM-H
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress if you are a recipient of the scholarship award

There is no deadline to apply.
