Pre-Nursing Advising Document for ADN Students

Instructions:

Please review this document as you prepare to apply to the nursing program. You must attend an information session and meet with your faculty advisor before you are eligible to apply. Your advisor will review your TEAS results, transfer courses, and pre-requisite course status. It is the student's responsibility to have official transcripts on file. Your advisor will confirm that you have requested transcripts and completed a transcript evaluation request.

This Pre-Nursing Advising Documentation must be complete and on file in the nursing department before the application period. Students are responsible for completing these requirements, meeting with a faculty advisor, securing initials and signatures, and submitting this form. Faculty advisor initials and signature must be included. Email this form to the nursing department at nursingapplications@jtcc.edu.

This document is due:

- **September 1** for spring applicants (starting in September 2022)
- **February 1** for fall applicants (starting in February 2023)

In addition to completing this pre-nursing advising document, **each student must submit a separate nursing application**.
