

2021-2022 NON-PARENTAL SUPPORT FORM

Federal financial aid regulations assume that the family has primary responsibility for meeting the educational costs of students. If you are considered a dependent student according to the federal financial aid definition, your aid eligibility is determined by using parent information in addition to your information.

You must meet at least one of the following criteria to be considered an independent student:

- Born before January 1, **1998**;
- Married;
- Enrolled in a graduate or professional degree program (beyond a bachelor's degree) in **2021-2022**;
- A veteran of the Armed Forces (or serving on active duty);
- Have children who receive more than half of their support from you;
- Have dependents (other than your children or spouse) who live with you and receive more than half of their support from you.
- At any time since age **13**; both parents deceased, been in foster care or dependent or ward of the court.
- An emancipated minor as determined by a court in your state of legal residence;
- In legal guardianship as determined by a court in your state of legal residence;
- At any time on or after July 1, **2020** - your high school or school district homeless liaison determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless - the director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless - the director of a runaway or homeless youth basic center or transitional living program determine that you were an unaccompanied youth who was homeless or were self-supporting and at risk of being homeless.

Based on the results of your **2021-2022** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you did not report information about your parent(s). Although students whose parents refuse support are not eligible for a dependency override, the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 (HEOA) granted that such students may receive unsubsidized Stafford loans only. Submitting this request does not guarantee approval. In addition, if your request is approved and you plan to attend school during a subsequent aid year, you must complete a request form for each new award year.

Complete this form only if **ALL** of the following are true:

- You do not receive **ANY** support from your parent(s); this includes insurance coverage, auto payments, or support of any kind.
- Your parent(s) have refused to complete the parent portion of the **2021-2022** FAFSA.
- You have met with a financial aid administrator to discuss your **2021-2022** FAFSA filing options.
