

Nursing Program Eligibility Requirements

In addition to the College's general admission requirements, applicants to the Nursing Program must meet the following criteria:

1. Be 18 years of age or older by the start date of the first nursing course.
2. Be enrolled as a student at JTCC.
3. Have completed all required placement testing (see Advising).
4. Have submitted all official transcripts from each school or college attended.
5. Be curriculum placed by the Advising Center
6. Students submitting an application during the Spring application period (for consideration for Fall admission into the Nursing program) must have completed or be currently enrolled in all prerequisite curricular courses at the time the application is submitted. All prerequisite curricular courses must be completed by the end of the Spring semester. Students submitting an application during the summer/Fall application period (for consideration for Spring admission into the Nursing program) must have completed or be currently enrolled in all prerequisite curricular courses at the time the application is submitted. All prerequisite curricular courses must be completed by the end of the Fall semester.
7. The prerequisite curricular courses are: ENG 111, BIO 141 (must be taken within 10 years of application), MTH 154 (or a higher level math), PSY 230, and SDV 100. A student must have earned a grade of "C" or better in all the prerequisite curricular courses.
8. Students must have a minimum prerequisite curricular GPA of 2.5. If a student has repeated one or more of the prerequisite curricular courses, only the higher grade will be used in the prerequisite curricular GPA calculation.
9. Applicants must complete the ATI TEAS test within three years prior to submitting the application. Applicants must achieve at least a minimum total score of 45% national percentile and achieve at least a minimum 45% national percentile in each of the four content areas of the test, Math, Reading, Science and English and Language Usage. Students may take the ATI TEAS up to three times. The ATI TEAS can be taken in the JTCC Testing Center.
